

## I'm a Non-resident. What licenses do I need?

Species Hunted	License(s) Non- Residents need :
Deer: Archery	Nonresident deer archery license (must renew Jan. 1)
Deer: Youth Gun	Must possess a nonresident deer gun license. Youth 7 years of age or under must be hunter education certified.
Deer: Muzzleloader	Nonresident deer primitive firearms license
Deer: Gun	Nonresident deer gun license
Deer: Holiday Antlerless	Nonresident deer gun license is valid for this season also
Elk	Nonresident elk license for each elk hunted and written landowner permission
Antelope	Nonresident antelope license for each antelope hunted and written landowner permission
Bear: Archery	Nonresident bear license (must be purchased prior to the start of archery season)
Bear: Muzzleloader	Nonresident bear license (must be purchased prior to the start of muzzleloader season). An unfilled bear archery license is also valid.
Squirrel, Rabbit, or Prairie Dog	Nonresident annual, fiscal or 5-day hunting license
Hog(feral swine)	Depends on the time of year. No hunting license is required to pursue hog, except on public lands (check the requirements for the specific area). However, individuals pursuing hog during antelope, bear, deer, or elk firearm seasons must have the appropriate license for that season.
Quail	Nonresident annual or fiscal hunting license
Pheasant	Nonresident annual, fiscal or 5-day hunting license
Turkey: Fall Archery	Nonresident annual or fiscal hunting license & fall turkey license for each bird hunted
Turkey: Fall Gun	Nonresident annual or fiscal hunting license & fall turkey license for each bird hunted
Turkey: Youth Spring	Youth 14 - 17 years old: Nonresident annual or fiscal hunting license & spring turkey license for each bird hunted. Youth under 14 years old: Spring turkey license for each bird hunted.
Turkey: Spring	Nonresident annual or fiscal hunting license & spring turkey license for each bird hunted
Dove, Rail (sora & Virginia), Gallinule (purple gallinule & common moorhen), Woodcock,	Nonresident annual, fiscal or 5-day hunting license & HIP ( Harvest Information Program) permit
Teal, Resident Canada Goose, Waterfowl (Ducks, Geese)	Nonresident annual, fiscal or 5-day hunting license & HIP ( Harvest Information Program) permit & State Waterfowl Stamp & Federal Migratory Bird Stamp
