Response summary

A roving creel survey of anglers was conducted during the Summer of 2022 at Ten Acre Park Pond in Choctaw by Oklahoma Fishery Research Laboratory personnel. Ten Acre Pond is one of 20 ponds in the Oklahoma City metropolitan that is managed under a cooperative agreement with the City of Choctaw and the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation. Angling pressure and harvest of stocked sunfish and catfish was unknown previously at the pond. Demand throughout the Summer was high for catchable sized fish. Anglers that were interviewed commonly stated that they fished here growing up, it's close to their residence, easy to fish on the way to or from work. 






Q13: Do you fish any other CTHFP ponds? Forty percent said "YES"


Q14: How was your fishing experience today? (1 Poor, 2 Fair, 3 OK, 4 Good, 5 Excellent) Average response rating was 3.8.

Q16: Did you spend any money to fish today?









Q18: Approve of daily limit of 3 aggregate? 75.5 % of respondents said "YES"
