Response summary

A roving creel survey of anglers was conducted during the Summer of 2022 at Beaty-Mulhausen Park Pond in Jones by Oklahoma Fishery Research Laboratory personnel. Beaty-Mulhausen Pond is one of 20 ponds in the Oklahoma City metropolitan that is managed under a cooperative agreement with the City of Choctaw and the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation. Angling pressure and harvest of stocked sunfish and catfish was unknown previously at the pond. Demand throughout the Summer was low for catchable sized fish. Anglers that were interviewed commonly stated that they fished here growing up, it's close to their residence, a nice park for family to come. 








Q9: What is your zip code?




Q17: What state fishing license do you have -
