

The Oklahoma Angler Survey is administered approximately every five years to a random sample of fishing license holders to learn about participation, preferences, as well as attitudes and opinions about certain topics. Three quarters of anglers take kids fishing.

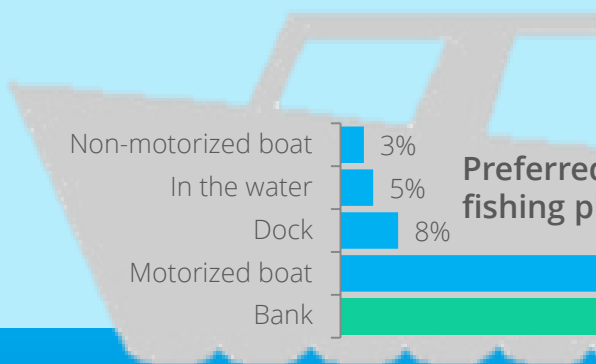


Average number of days anglers spent fishing over the course of a year.

The most important reason anglers go fishing is to enjoy nature and the outdoors.



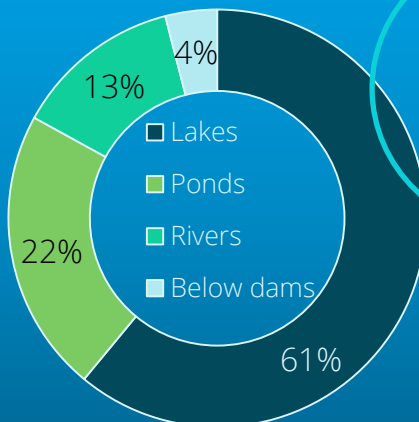
